CLEANER STREETS—Conservative Budget Proposals reinstate £1m towards street cleaning, fly tipping and dog fouling across the District

LOWER COUNCIL TAX—Six Years of Labour has increased Council Tax by 25%, yet they hold £26m of reserves in the bank.

Community Halls & Public Toilets have closed & Museum opening times have reduced. Valuable Tourist Information Centres (TICs) have been closed in Saltaire, Haworth & Ilkely, whilst the largest & least used one in the City Centre remains open.

DYNAMITE PROPOSALS BY LABOUR—

Council Departments have recently moved into brand new offices to allow demolition of Jacob's Well, their former accommodation. The building has now been blown up—spectacularly, not long after a full refurbishment.

EVEN MORE SPECTACULAR—Labour spent £4.2m to buy a multi-storey car park (Hall Ings NCP) to pull down, to use the land for, quote......car parking!

SUPPORT VULNERABLE CHILDREN & ADULTS—Childrens' Centres are under threat and 38 carer posts remain unfilled. Labour cuts to Foster Carers' pay and Adult Carers' allowances have led good people to quit and work for other local councils. The Conservative Government have given them £6.5m extra funding to help overcome such



NEAREST GOOD SCHOOL—The Conservatives believe that every child should be able to attend the nearest good school to their home.

OUR CHILDREN DESERVE BETTER—Bradford's education standards for combined Reading, Writing and Maths are ranked 126th out of 152 local authorities nationally and still falling.

GIVE YOUTH A HOPE—When early intervention & apprenticeships for our young people are important, why has the Labour Council decimated Youth Service Funding?

POTHOLES BEING "LOOKED INTO" - Whilst vehicle damage claims cost the council £85,000 Every year, they have spent £15k on a now rusting metal "baby" statue in front of their new council offices. A colour changing lighting effect costing £12k has also been fitted onto the building's perimeter. Sadly, gulley & leaf clearing and pothole filling doesn't get much priority.

EXTRA CASH—The Conservative Group lobbied Government and received £600k extra cash in 2018, enough to fill 12,000 potholes in our district. With claims for damage at an all time high, when will the work be evident?

STOP PAYING WAGES—We would lobby the government to amend legislation, to avoid the council paying full time union officials and their office costs, which should be met by the unions themselves through member subscriptions. .

SAVE RATEPAYERS' MONEY—Reduce the cost of local elections by moving from annual, to all out councillor elections, once every four years.
